英文面試注意事項

- 面試穿著,雖然現今沒有太多特殊要求,多數也無需穿正式套裝,還是要避免穿著露出腳趾的鞋子或過於休閒的衣著。
- · 面試後請記得回到家或隔天記得傳遞一封感謝函,並在一週內做後續 follow up。
- 即便應試公司未要求,不妨另外準備一份履歷及作品集備著。
- 在前往應試公司前,最好再次確認地點及交通路線,避免太早到或是遲到。
- 前往應試公司前,記得先了解對方公司的介紹、產品內容等大項。

Q: Tell me about yourself. 請介紹你自己。

O Don't dos

講古、不重要資訊、工作無關的內容 例如:就讀哪間國小、中、高,父母職位等

Tips

工作經歷 → 歷練的專業能力 → 加以進修項目 → 興趣

簡短介紹即可,利用履歷上的自我介紹加減修改成「至少1-2分鐘的內容。」 例如:



學生:簡短介紹自己的社團經驗、在校成績、興趣、作品。



非新鮮人:可運用循序漸進的方式,從工作經歷帶到歷練過的能力,再帶到自己想加以進修的部分,最後可以簡單地帶上自己的興趣。

(要注意!!興趣最好是能輔佐自己能力的為主)

A:

A:

One of my weaknesses is that I am an idealist. Whenever I finish a project, I would reflect on what I've done even if it's in good progress. This results in me spending too much time on one project, thus delaying the others. In order to solve this problem, I've set an agenda to help me stay on track and also break each project down into mini tasks. If I spend too much time on one project, I'll move on and come back later. By the time I come back to the unfinished project I tend to be more objective about whether or not more work is needed.

A:

This shows that your company takes great care of your clients and employees as well. Also in the past year, your company has designed several outstanding products that have caught my eyes. I am sure that my experiences can benefit your company. Furthermore, I can learn a lot as well. It would be a great honor to be able to join your company.

Open Don't dos

不要在訴說的時候將責任全歸咎於 前東家或同事。



Tips

可以先以自己想得到的比較大的案子 或是經驗去帶到自己遇到的狀況,並加 上解決辦法跟結果。

Early in my career, when I was working in a department store, there was one time when I was in charge of the advertisement flyers for a whole season. On the printing date, there was something that the project planner left out, and I didn't double check as well. That caused our company to throw the first 10,000 copies away and had to reprint it all over again. We then came up with a better workflow afterwards and I made sure to double check the contents with other teams involved.

In three years, I'd like to be in a position where I know more about my long-term career aspirations as an art director. I'll have improved and acquired both technical skills and marketing skills. And when the time is right, I'll take the opportunity to pursue my doctoral degree in movie design.

In three years, I'd like to be in a position (期望職位). I'll have improved and acquired (技能/知識). And when the time is right, I'll take the opportunity to pursue (未來目標).

Q: What can you do for us that other candidates can't?

O Don't dos

不要直接説不知道、不確定, 或是直接沒有自信。

Tips

可以自己的專長先去包裝,若真的是毫無經驗 可以用刻苦耐勞或肯學習等方向去讓對方知道 你的毅力跟決心。

I am uniquely qualified for this position because I am incredibly organized and open to learning new things, and I'm not just saying that - I live for my planner and I always plan ahead. In my past role as a graphic designer, not only was I constantly designing flyers and dms on a daily basis, but I also taught myself Adobe Premiere due to the need of editing movie trailers. So I'm sure that I'll be able to face anything no matter what the challenge may be.

What are the biggest challenges that someone in this position would face? 您認為此職位會面臨到最大的挑戰為何?

Could you tell me more about your new products or plans for growth? 您能向我介紹更多關於新產品或是未來發展的部分嗎?

Can you tell me about the team I'll work with? 能跟我介紹一下未來工作團隊嗎?

Is there anything else I can provide you with that would be helpful? 是否有什麼資訊是我能提供您並能幫助到我應徵此職位的呢?

Q: Describe yourself in one word. 請用一個字形容你自己。

O Don't dos

不要單用簡單的形容詞像 是good, nice。

Tips

提前搜尋一些在團隊特質中有幫助的單字、或是 能夠突顯你自己個人特色的單詞。

A:

Definitely responsible. I always make sure our team meets every objective. Definitely (特質). I always (說明原因).

特質的單詞用語

- Successful (若是有經營副業,且經營的不錯的話很適合用)
- Motivated (可用來表示就算個人作業也沒有問題)
- Strategic (若是管理職或是企劃執行非常適用)
- Productive (美術設計等類型, 高產能)



Q: Who's the most important person in your life? Why?

On't dos

不要直接説不知道,或只單回答一個人,然後沒有敘述 和結尾。

Tips

可以從身邊的朋友或長輩去開啟,不需要很天花亂墜的故事,可用這個人待人處事的精神,帶出給你的啟發。

A:

My brother for sure. He's been through a lot of ups and downs, but no matter how hard the situation is, he never gives up. Although he complains a bit from time to time, but the most important thing is that he doesn't quit doing the things he loves or believes in and he always stays true. I see that as an inspiration and a reminder: To always stay who you are, and don't be a quitter.

I even briefly considered quitting when I knew I couldn't come close to the goals. But instead, I decided to focus on the things I could control and communicated with our client. In the end, we came to an agreement and created something we both liked and was proud of.
